## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

### 1. ADMINISTRATION

#### 1.1 Nature of the Event

The Touring Assembly, to be known as the Evan Green Memorial, hereinafter called the Event, will be a Multiclub event, conducted on public roads in the Markwell, Gloucester and Rawdon Vale regions of NSW, on Saturday, 16th November 2013.

#### 1.2 Authority and Permit

The Event will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of CAMS, the National Rally Code (NRC) these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations that may be issued.

The event will be conducted under & in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk management policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)

Insurance for this event shall be in accordance with Appendix I of the CAMS Manual.

The Event will be held under CAMS Permit Number: 213/1611/03

#### 1.4 Invited Clubs

All Cams affiliated Car Clubs. All Historic registered vehicles are encouraged to enter.

#### 1.5 Alteration, Abandonment or Termination of the Event

The Organisers reserve the right to abandon, alter or terminate the Event at any point in accordance with the National Competition Rules (NCR 59).

## **2. COMPETITORS AND ENTRIES**

The organisers have the authority to refuse entries at their discretion. The organisers being the elected AHRG Committee as well as the event officials listed above.

### **2.1 Crew Members**

Crew members will be a minimum of two people and a maximum not more than the legal seating capacity of the vehicle.

Each member of the crew will be required to be a member of the Australian Historic Rally Group Inc. or one of the invited clubs, and proof of membership must be shown to the Event Secretary at Scrutineering.

Competitors under the age of 18 years must have the written consent of a parent or guardian in order to enter and participate. The minimum age for competitors is 14 years of age.

Passengers as defined by NCR 46 may be carried. There is no age limit for passengers.

### **2.2 Entries**

Entries must be made on the official entry form, and sent together with the entry fee to the Event Secretary, Karen Piggott, PO Box 405 Morisset 2264

Entries open with publication of these Supplementary Regulations

Entries close on Saturday, 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2013.

The entry fee is \$60.00 per competing vehicle.

Entries will be accepted on the day of the event but will attract a \$5.00 late entry fee.

Changes in the crew and/or vehicle will be permitted prior to the Start of the Event with no penalty. Any changes after the Start will be at the discretion of the Clerk of Course or Clerk of Course's nominee.

### **2.3 Licences**

The Driver/s must hold a current valid civil driving licence.

The Competitor and at least one crew member must hold a current CAMS level 2 (L2NS) or higher CAMS Licence.

New L2NS and L2S licences can be obtained from CAMS. Renewals must be done through the CAMS office, PO Box 147 Caulfield East 3145 or via their website. Allow time for new licence processing as an application form has to be completed by the applicant.

### **2.4 Starting Order**

The Starting Order will be determined by ballot, after the Competitors' Briefing.

### **2.5 Competitors' Briefing**

**Scrutineering will take place at the Boral Caltex Service Station from 9.30am**

**A Competitors' Briefing will be held at 10:30am on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2013 at the Start Location, Caltex Service Station Boral, Ph 49 949 162**

Attendance by at least one member of each crew is compulsory. Failure to attend will incur a 15-point event penalty, in addition to penalties imposed by the Stewards.

### **2.6 Protests**

Any query that cannot be resolved by negotiation with the Organising Committee will be dealt with in accordance with Part XII of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

## **3. VEHICLES**

### **3.1 Eligibility**

The club fosters the use of vehicles first manufactured 20 years prior to the event, but any vehicle is welcome.

Unregistered vehicle permits will be accepted.  
 Each vehicle must be currently road registered, including historic registrations.  
 Current vehicles are accepted but will not be eligible for prizes.  
 Compulsory equipment will include  
 Proof of current registration for the entered vehicle  
 Driver & crew's current club membership.  
 Driver's CAMS licence

### 3.2 Classes

Vehicles will be allocated to one of the following classes:

Class A	Up to 31/12/67 (No run ons)	Class B	1/1/68 to 31/12/75
Class C	1/1/76 to 31/12/85	Class D	1/1/86 to 31/12/1992

X class for current cars will be 01/01/1993 onwards.

The AHRG Eligibility Officer, Peter Meddows, is available for a decision as to which Class your vehicle fits if you are unsure. Peter can be contacted on (02) 4936 1588 after hours.

The Organisers reserve the right to combine classes if there are fewer than 3 entries per class.

### 3.3 Vehicle Condition

It is the responsibility of the Competitor and/or the Driver to ensure the vehicle is in a road-safe condition, both at the start and during the Event. Vehicles will be checked at Scrutineering prior to the commencement of the Event and may be checked at any time by the Officials.

Except in control areas Vehicles may be worked on at any time during the Event without penalty.

### 3.4 Compulsory Equipment

No equipment is compulsory. Fire extinguishers, first aid kits, and driven wheel mud flaps are recommended.

## 5. EVENT FORMAT

### 5.1 Sections and Distance

The Event will be conducted on public roads, over a total distance of approximately 240 kms, of which 20% will be bitumen and 80% will be gravel approximately. The longest distance between refuelling service stations will be 105 kms.

## 5.2 Route Instructions

Instructions for the Event will be issued two minutes before each car starts. All instructions will be given in kilometres only. The Instructions will be given in the form of map reading & route charts.

Questions & test instructions will be given verbally at set points during the event.

## 5.3 Observers

There may be observers, who will be judges of fact, positioned along the route.

## 5.4 Route Checks

Route Checks may be manned or unmanned. They will be identified by boards that will be on display at the Competitors Briefing.

At Manned Route Checks, all competitors must stop and have their Road Cards signed.

When an Unmanned Route Check is sighted, its identifier must be written on the Road Card.

## 6. SCORING

### 6.1 Results

Scoring will be on the basis of the correct marking of the Manned Route Checks and the correct listing of Unmanned Route Checks as shown on the crew's Road Card, and the correct answers to questions listed at certain mileages in the instructions. The scores will be added together, and the competitors with the lowest number of points will be adjudged the winners of their class.

There will be no tie breakers.

### 6.2 Penalties

Failure to attend Competitors Briefing	15
Incorrect or missing Route Check	15
Correct answer	0
Incorrect answer	1

Points loss in independent tests will be shown on test instruction.

### 6.4 Awards

Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third outright.

First in class or category

Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s). The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence.
