

DES WEST MEMORIAL 20th JUNE 2021

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. ADMINISTRATION. MOTORSPORT AUST. PERMIT No. 221/206/013.

In case of an emergency or withdrawal from the Event, the Directors may be contacted during the Event by mobile phone: **0437 673 932.**

1.1 NATURE OF THE EVENT

The event, to be known as, **Des West Memorial**, hereinafter called the Event, will be a Multiclub Social event, conducted on public roads in the state of NSW commencing on **20/6/2021.** The event will be a round of the AHRG Club Championship.

1.3 THE EVENT

The Event will start at **Teralba Amateur Sailing Club car park, off First St, BOORAGUL NSW** and follow a simple navigation throughout the Event. The finish will be at a designated location at **Hunter Valley Resort, Hermitage Rd POKOLBIN NSW.** All vehicles must be road registered; proof of registration will be required. The Event will be untimed. Road rules and regulations are to be adhered to during the event. Anyone NOT complying with the rules will be reported to the organising committee with a penalty up to and including exclusion from the event.

1.4 ALL historic registered vehicles with a European origin are encouraged to enter this event. Left hand drive and "Rare" cars are most welcome. Late model vehicles may enter but will be ineligible for outright placings.

1.5 INVITED CLUBS All affiliated Car Clubs are invited.

1.6 ALTERATION, ABANDONMENT OR TERMINATION OF THE EVENT Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the Event due to government health warnings, weather events or unforeseen circumstances.

2. COMPETITORS AND ENTRIES

The Organisers have the authority to refuse entries, the Organisers being the elected AHRG Committee.

2.1 CREW MEMBERS

Crews will consist of a minimum of two people and a maximum not exceeding the legal seating capacity of the vehicle.

Competitors under the age of 18 years must have the written consent of a parent or guardian in order to enter and participate. The minimum age for competitors is 14 years of age.

2.2 ENTRIES

Entries must be made on the attached official entry form and sent together proof of entry fee to the Event Secretary via email to **secretary.ahrg@gmail.com** or

Fees are payable via EFT only; no cash or cheques will be accepted.

Entry and proof of payment must be received before COB 18th June 2021.

Entries close **18th June 2021**. Entries open with publication of these Supplementary Regulations.

Changes to the crew and/or vehicle may be permitted prior to the Start of the Event at the discretion of the organisers with no penalty. Any changes after the Start will be at the discretion of the Event Director.

2.3 LICENCES

The Driver/s must hold a current valid civil driving licence.

2.4 SCRUTINEERING

Self-scrutineering will be required and documentation provided prior to the Event

2.5 STARTING ORDER

The Starting Order will be determined by order of receipt of entry at the director's discretion.

2.6 DRIVERS' BRIEFING

A Drivers' Briefing will be held 9:30 am, car park, BOORAGUL.

Attendance by at least one member of each crew is compulsory. Failure to attend will incur a 15-point penalty.

3. VEHICLES

3.1 ELIGIBILITY

The club fosters the entry of vehicles first manufactured 30 years prior to the Event date. Each vehicle must be currently road registered, including Historic and Classic.

As this is an Australian Historic Rally Group Event, older vehicles are encouraged to compete, however later vintages up to and including current models are accepted but those vehicles will be classified Class X.

Class X vehicles are not eligible for outright positions and will receive class positions only.

3.2 CLASSES

Vehicles will be graded as per AHRG classes relating to age and categorised by **Peter Meadows**, Eligibility Officer.

3.3 VEHICLE CONDITION

It is the responsibility of the Entrant and/or the Driver to ensure the vehicle is in a road-safe condition, both at the start and during the Event. Vehicles are to be self-scrutineered prior to the commencement of the Event and may be checked at any time by the Officials for compliance.

All vehicles shall be equipped with a functioning distance measuring device, an odometer recording either Miles or Kilometres will also be acceptable.

3.4 VEHICLE AND CREW COMPLIANCE.

Compulsory equipment will include:

Seatbelts for each occupant, where fitted. Operational distance measuring device.

Proof of current registration for the entered vehicle,

e.g. Registration papers as issued by the RMS.

Driver's current Civil Driving Licence.

Driver and crew's current club membership.

Recommended, but not compulsory:

Two reflective triangles.

First Aid kit. Fire extinguisher. Mud flaps for each driven wheel.

4. SCHEDULE

Entries open Entries close Scrutineering Drivers' Briefing First Car Starts First Car Finishes On publication of these Regulations. 18th June 2021. Self scrutineering prior to Event. 9:30 am, car park, BOORAGUL. 10:00 am. Approx 1:30 pm.

5. EVENT FORMAT

5.1 SECTIONS AND DISTANCE

The Event will be conducted on public roads, over a total distance of about **220 klm**, **75%** of which is bitumen. The longest distance between refuelling service stations will be about **80 km**.

5.2 FUEL At 80 Km's and at 160 k's

5.3 ROUTE INSTRUCTIONS

Instructions for the Event will be issued two minutes before each car starts. Instructions for the Event may be given as fully route charted, with Tulip arrows.

5.4 ODOMETER CHECK

The survey car recorded **5.60 kms** following the main road between the following points; Bus Stop (post) – Front of Mines Rescue Station, 533 Lake Rd ARGENTON NSW. Traffic Lights (stop line) – Cnr Toronto Rd & Enterprise Way, WOODRISING NSW.

5.6 ABREVIATIONS

Abbreviations that may be used in the Instructions to Navigators:

T.L.	Turn Left	T.R.	Turn Right	S.O.	Straight On
B.L.	Bear Left	B.R.	Bear Right	R.J.	Road Junction
T.H.L	. Turn Hard Left	T.H.R	. Turn Hard Right	T.J.	"T" Junction
X.R.	Cross Road	F.M.R	. Follow Main Road	S.P.	Sign Post

Points of the compass may also be employed, e.g. N.E. for North East etc when specifying a direction of travel.

6. SCORING

6.1 Results

Scoring will be judged by Observation questions that will be used throughout the Event. Other skills testing may also be employed in order to determine a clear winner at the discretion of the Director and/or Organising Committee, i.e. Photo points or other proof of compliance with the instructions, including distance travelled.

6.2 PENALTIES	
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Failure to attend Drivers' Briefing	10 points
Trivia Questions	1 point

Only to be used in the case of a tied score Kilometre or mileage check. Compared to the directors' measurements. 1 point/0.1 km

6.3 EVENT WINNER

The winner of the event shall be the competitor who successfully completes the full course with the least number of points lost.

7.1 TROPHIES WILL BE AWARDED AS LISTED.
1st 2nd & 3rd Outright.
1st in class or category
Best Junior entry (under the age of 18)

7.2 TROPHIES WILL BE PRESENTED AT THE NEXT BI-MONTHLY MEETING OF THE AHRG.
