Time is ticking away so if you plan to be part of Rally Roads to Raleigh you better get those Motels booked. The Sawtell Motor Inn is booked out so you could try, The Coasters Motel, 77 First Ave, Sawtell, Ph 6653 1541, I know nothing about this Motel other than its in Sawtell. Or check out the internet for Motels in Coffs Harbour. In Armidale try, the Moore Park Inn, Uralla Rd, Armidale, Ph 6772 2358.

Armidale Friday the 13th of May

Food; There is no organized lunches or dinners, but.

Day one; Raymond Terrace to Armidale, lunch will be in Gloucester. There are a number of take away shops and Café in Gloucester or you could bring your own. The route stops at a Park just out of Gloucester. Moore Park Inn has a restaurant which would be a good spot for dinner.

Day two; Armidale to Sawtell (Coffs Harbour), the nature of the route makes lunch problematical. We will be in Dorrigo a bit early for lunch but if you spend some time at the scenic lookout it might work. The Heritage Hotel (where we stayed last time) serves lunch from 11.30. The internet tells me there are a number of take away shops and Café's in Dorrigo but I have to say, they didn't jump out at me as I drove through town. It may be a matter of stopping and going for a walk. Dinner; The main street of Sawtell seems to be endless take away shops, café's and Restaurants plus a pub and RSL club so if in Sawtell you will be spoilt for choice.

Day Three; Raleigh Raceway; The action starts at 9.00 am so you will need to be there around 8.00 or 8.30 am. Give yourself enough time to fill in a form, attach the timer, empty your car etc. Finish time is 1.00 pm.

I will have 14 cameras around the track to record the action plus a couple of GoPro cameras to go on cars. So the event should be recorded for prosperity.

Start; Kloster Ford, Adelaide St, Raymond Terrace

Day two Sawtell/Coffs Harbour
Day three Raleigh Raceway

Distance; 600 km, give or take 100 km.
